Problem gambling warning signs:



Spending more time or money on gambling than planned or able to afford



Hiding lottery tickets from other people



Neglecting important responsibilities to play lottery games



Continuing to gamble after repeated attempts to stop



Borrowing money to gamble



Gambling to try and forget problems and/or reduce stress

Problem gambling can affect anyone, regardless of age, gender or ethnicity. Knowing the key signs of problem gambling and how to get help are crucial to addressing gambling problems.

Watch the clock and keep track of how much time you are devoting to the lottery. Don't let the lottery negatively impact your time with family and friends.

It is fun to dream about winning a big jackpot, but you can never count on winning money. Play the Illinois Lottery as a fun or social activity - not as a way to earn money.
