



Request for Proposals for the Design and Manufacture of Instant Ticket Dispensers

July 30, 2018

1 Introduction

The Illinois Department of the Lottery (“Department” or “Illinois Lottery”) www.illinoislottery.com awarded the Private Management Agreement (“PMA”) to Camelot Illinois LLC (“Camelot Illinois”) on September 22, 2017 following a bid submission. Following the Notice of Award, the PMA was executed on October 13, 2017.

Camelot Illinois is a leading technology and services provider that supports the Illinois Lottery. As part of an overall business strategy, it intends to assist the Department in growing revenue.

A key component of Camelot Illinois’ retail plans for FY19 and beyond is to transform the retail experience by investing in new permanent point of sale (“PPOS”) equipment. The goal of this project is to modernize all PPOS fixtures and displays to optimize the promotion of Illinois Lottery products sold in retail stores. The scope of the project includes the design, manufacture, logistics, warehousing, and installation of all PPOS assets in scope (See Appendix B and C of this RFP for the full scope of the project).

The goal of this Request for Proposals for the Design and Manufacture of Instant Ticket Dispensers (“RFP”) is to procure new Illinois Lottery instant ticket dispensers (“Dispensers”) that meet the following requirements:

- A. Modular- divisible by one column of dispensers
- B. Able to present an instant ticket to the customer (full ticket)
- C. Able to hold a full pack of instant tickets
- D. Securable to counters and have the ability to fit security wings, header boards, temporary point of sale and jackpot communication.

Please see the instant Ticket Dispensers Detailed Specifications, attached hereto as Appendix B and C, for the complete set of requirements. The intent is to place the Dispensers in every retail outlet that can accommodate them as the primary Illinois Lottery selling solution. Since retailers will change their current dispensers over time, Camelot Illinois will require a starting quantity, warehouse quantity, and the ability to purchase Dispensers on an ongoing basis.

2 Instructions

This RFP invites interested organizations to submit a response (“Proposal”) to Camelot Illinois.

The requirements for the Proposal are set forth in Section 7 of this RFP, as further elaborated in Appendix B and C.

Proposals submitted late will not be considered.

2.4 Vendor Meeting/Presentation

Those Vendors deemed responsive after the initial point scoring may be selected to go forward and given the opportunity to demonstrate their ability to meet Camelot Illinois' requirements through Vendor meetings and/or presentations.

Arrangements will be made following receipt of the Proposals.

2.5 Response Format

Please provide the following information on the cover page of Vendor's Proposal and ensure that Vendor's name appears on each subsequent page of the document:

- A. Vendor's Name;
- B. Vendor's Address;
- C. Contact Name;
- D. Contact Job Title;
- E. E-mail Address; and
- F. Telephone Number.

Ensure that Vendor's Proposal follows Camelot Illinois' format (e.g., numbering answers in the format of this document). Failure to do so may result in the Proposal being misinterpreted or missed. Please answer all questions fully. Proposals should be delivered in electronic format via email to procurement-services@camelotillinois.com

The Proposal should explain how the Vendor could support Camelot Illinois in the achievement of its objectives.

Where possible, the Proposal should also include the following:

- A. Innovative ideas on meeting Camelot Illinois' requirements;
- B. Why Camelot Illinois should choose the Vendor; and
- C. How the Vendor's service offering differs from the competition.

3 Conditions of the RFP

3.1 General Considerations

The issuance of this RFP does not constitute a legal offer capable of acceptance.

Camelot Illinois reserves the right to reject any or all of the Proposals submitted or to withdraw this RFP at any time. Camelot Illinois also reserves the right to accept a Proposal from Vendors in part only.

Camelot Illinois will not be liable for any costs incurred by any Vendor in connection with the preparation of a response to this RFP or for any costs incurred for attendance at meetings, presentations, clarifications, or demonstrations.

The numbering of this RFP is an important aid in the evaluation process. Please utilize it within the Proposal, as this may affect Camelot Illinois' evaluation of it.

Prospective Vendors may not take advantage of any apparent error or omission in this RFP. In the event that any errors or omissions are discovered, a Vendor shall notify Camelot Illinois immediately.

Please provide complete and accurate information against the specifications contained within this RFP. If Vendor is unable to meet any requirements, then this should be clearly noted in the appropriate response section(s). Any assumptions within the Proposal should be clearly stated.

Any commitment made in a Proposal shall be binding on the applicable Vendor. A commitment includes any guarantee or representation made in the Proposal, accompanying documentation, or subsequent negotiation.

3.2 Confidentiality

Subject to Appendix A - Private Manager Agreement Incorporated Terms ("Incorporated Terms"), of this RFP, any information disclosed in, or in connection with this RFP becomes the property of Camelot Illinois, subject to Vendor's redaction of confidential, proprietary, or other sensitive material in accordance with the Incorporated Terms and State Policies and Rules (defined in the Incorporated Terms). Such information will be available to the public in accordance with State Policies and Rules. The failure to designate any materials as "proprietary and confidential" at the time of delivery of such information to Camelot Illinois does not prohibit the Vendor from subsequently designating any information as proprietary and confidential. However, this designation does not necessarily exempt such information from disclosure under the Freedom of Information Act, 5 ILCS 140/1 *et seq.*

3.3 Employment

From the time this RFP is issued until either (i) six (6) months after the award of a contract pursuant to this RFP or (ii) the rejection of all Proposals received by Camelot Illinois, Vendors are prohibited from officially or unofficially making any employment offer or proposing any business arrangement with Camelot Illinois' employees.

3.4 Compliance

Failure to comply with any specific instructions detailed in this RFP may, at Camelot Illinois' discretion, exclude the Vendor from further consideration in the process.

3.5 Selection of Vendor

Any Proposal that materially fails to meet the requirements set forth in this RFP will be disqualified.

Camelot Illinois reserves the right to adjust selection criteria until August 20, 2018. Any such changes will be posted on the Illinois Lottery website no later than August 22, 2018, 2018 to permit any necessary refinement of Proposals prior to submission. Camelot Illinois will notify all Vendors who have submitted an intent to bid notice of all changes via notice posted on procurement-services@camelotillinois.com.

Camelot Illinois' decision on the winning Vendor ("Supplier") will be determined by the highest overall score(s) achieved based on the above criteria and, if appropriate, updated following any presentations. Camelot Illinois' decision will be final.

3.6 Terms and Conditions

Vendors should note that any contract award will also be subject to Camelot Illinois' terms and conditions.

Camelot Illinois operates within a regulated environment, and it is a requirement of the PMA that Vendors be vetted or approved by the State regulator in advance. Accordingly, the Supplier must complete State disclosure and certification documents, located at <https://ipg.vendorreg.com/>. For further information about this requirement, please contact, Procurement at procurement-services@camelotillinois.com.

The PMA requires Camelot Illinois to pass through various non-negotiable provisions, specifically the Incorporated Terms, to all Suppliers. Camelot Illinois will achieve this by adding a separate exhibit with Incorporated Terms onto each Supplier's contract. The Incorporated Terms will take priority over any conflicting term in the rest of the contract. Refer to Appendix A of this RFP for a final version of the Incorporated Terms.

From the time this RFP is issued until the end of the contract term, each Vendor represents and warrants that it shall neither be (i) debarred or prohibited from doing business with the State of Illinois for any reason; nor (ii) likely to have a material and/or adverse effect on the interests of the Illinois Lottery.

Camelot Illinois is looking to establish a contract with a Supplier for a term of approximately three (3) years, subject to the Supplier's performance and Camelot Illinois' evolving requirements and strategy.

3.7 Validity of Proposal

Proposals shall be binding offers, binding for a period of ninety (90) days from the date the Proposal is submitted.

4 Estimated Timings

4.1 Dispenser timings

Camelot Illinois intends to secure a Vendor that can begin tooling as early as **October 2018** (note this date is subject to change, subject to length of contract negotiations and is indicative only). The Instant Ticket Dispenser is the key feature of the counter setup and will structurally support other counter items. Manufacture of the Dispensers should commence around November 2018, and it is anticipated manufacturing will be complete by January 2019.

The following is a high-level project timeline (dates are subject to change):

- A. Award RFP: September 21, 2018;
- B. Enter into contract: September 2018;
- C. Tooling: October 2018;
- D. Manufacture Dispensers: November 2018 - January 2019;
- E. Shipping: January 2019; and
- F. 1st shipment received in Illinois: January 2019.

5 Response Approach and Format

Vendors are requested to provide the following:

- A. A completed version of the Company Information section with brief responses;
- B. A completed version of the Requirements section with full responses against each requirement (where applicable); and
- C. A completed pricing schedule estimate with any variation included at the end.

Where necessary, Vendors may supplement responses with additional material but should ensure that the material focuses on the information requested and references the section for which it applies. Camelot Illinois may be unable to search through generic material to attempt to find relevant information.

If the Vendor must exclude some requirements from its Proposal, this should be accompanied by a clear statement of which items are excluded and why.

If the Vendor wishes to propose additional services, not mentioned in the requirements in order to supply a full-service solution, please provide a clear statement of what additional items are included and why.

1.1 INTRODUCTION

This section gives potential vendors the necessary detail required to price and quote for the design and manufacture of instant ticket dispensers.

As stated in this RFP, the instant ticket dispenser is pivotal to the success of the sale of Lottery in Illinois. The instant ticket category makes up around 65% of overall sales. The display of instant tickets in a purpose-built dispenser will make access for customers and retailers simpler.

The instant ticket dispenser is an integral part of a family of other PPOS items (detailed within Section 2 ‘PPOS Family Summary’) that will refresh the Illinois Lottery brand across the majority of retail outlets. These items form another RFP as part of this programme.

The intention is to design a new dispenser configuration so that Camelot Illinois can:

- Secure space in retail outlets that don’t currently have instant tickets on front of counter;
- Make the instant ticket selling space more secure for retailers; and
- Improve the look and feel of dispensers and ensure instant tickets can be displayed in an uncluttered way.

Importantly, the dispenser cassettes have been provisionally designed with manufacturing intent to connect together as single cassettes to make larger displays. The cassettes have also been designed to ensure they connect to the external frame of the units - this feature is shown in the detailed drawings set out in Section 4 Technical Drawings)

The dispenser configuration has been designed to have a gentle curve from bottom to top (front to back). This aim of this curve is to provide greater accessibility to consumers shopping the dispenser over and above a flat fronted dispenser. It will also assist in ensuring that the dispenser gets prime position on counter in retail outlets while creating an appealing space for customers to shop.

1.2. INSTANT TICKET DISPENSER - CASSETTE REQUIREMENTS

The following sets out the high level requirements that must be met in the design of Instant Ticket Dispenser cassette modules and their fixing mechanisms.

- Display a full instant ticket - sizes are 3”-5”-7.5”- 8”
- Cassette Size / Ticket size for dispenser
 - ✧ 4” - \$1, \$2
 - ✧ 6” - \$1, \$2, \$3, \$5, \$10
 - ✧ 8” - \$3, \$5, \$10, \$20, \$30

*(all packs of instant tickets will be provided on request to potential vendors)
- Displays a large ticket (Gigantix) that is 8” wide
- Holds a full book of instant tickets securely at all price points

- Dispenses instant tickets without damaging them
- Ensure cassette has a rear door (not provided in the detailed drawings to allow vendors to apply their incumbent style) that has the following features:
 - ✧ A secure locking mechanism;
 - ✧ Ability to dispense instant tickets without marking or damaging ticket;
 - ✧ Rear loading of a full pack of instant tickets; and
 - ✧ Allow for ejection and removal of a single ticket by store staff.
- Are modular and capable of being attached together to create towers or other simple structures
- Accepts numbers and/or letters for customer and retailer selection
- Can be secured to multiple types of counter surfaces, including, but not limited to, wood, metal, acrylic, and stone
- Can be removed easily from the base or stand for overnight safe storage
- Cassettes are manufactured in the materials specified (Section 3 - Tooling and Finishes schedule). If vendors would like to move away from the material selection, a full cost and breakage analysis must be provided to support

Although design intent is set out in Section 4 “Technical Drawings’ and addresses most of the requirements listed above, it is the ultimate responsibility of the chosen vendor to ensure that requirements above are met.

Potential Vendors must provide a solution to guarantee that instant tickets are displayed in the front of the dispenser and can be held in place while dispensing without seeing ‘air gaps’.

Note - all finished products to be suitably packaged to protect during shipping and delivered palletized on standard US pallets.

1.3 INSTANT TICKET DISPENSER - CONSIDERATIONS

The requirements below are considerations that vendors should be aware of. These are not part of this RFP, however could impact any final cassette design.

The dispensers must be able to:

- Display point of sale (“POS”) marketing materials and be compatible with jackpot communication signs and their mounting mechanisms
- Accept header boards, such as brand advertisements
- Accept security wings or panels to prevent customer theft
