CHANGES EFFECTIVE AFTER MARCH 29, 2021, DRAW AT 9:22 PM CT

Exciting changes are being made to Lotto effective March 29, 2021. We're giving players more chances to win, more millions to play for, and better odds of winning. Read on to see how all of these changes will benefit you and your players!

What do these changes mean for you?

- These changes are expected to increase your Lotto sales.
- The odds of winning have improved to give players a better chance to win.
- When players win non-top prizes, they are more likely to reinvest those winnings in your store!

Lotto upgrades quick overview

- Each Lotto play automatically enters the same six numbers into three separate drawings: the main Lotto Jackpot, Lotto Million 1, and Lotto Million 2.
- The Lotto Million 1 and Lotto Million 2 drawings each have a prize of \$1,000,000.
- Players will select six numbers from 1 to 50, instead of 52, which improves the odds of winning the game.
- The overall odds of the game have improved to 1 in 6.9.
- The ticket cost has increased from \$1 to \$2.

What is staying the same?

- The starting main Lotto Jackpot remains at \$2 million with \$150,000 incremental increases.
- Draw days and time will remain the same.
- The draw cutoff is still 9:15 PM CT on a draw day.
- The EXTRA SHOT® add-on is still \$1 per play and only applies to the non-top prizes of the main Lotto Jackpot (i.e., it does not apply to the Lotto Jackpot, Lotto Million 1, or Lotto Million 2).
- The terminal still randomly selects the EXTRA SHOT number.
- Players can still increase their winnings for non-top prizes of the main Lotto Jackpot with EXTRA SHOT. See Lotto Prizes and Odds chart below.

How to play

- Players select six numbers from ① - ⑤① on the new play slip, select Quick Pick from the Win30 terminal, or ask the sales clerk for a Quick Pick. The player is automatically entered into three separate drawings: Lotto Jackpot, Lotto Million 1, and Lotto Million 2.
- The Extra Shot option can be selected for \$1 per game and applies to all plays on a play slip. However, it only applies to the non-top prizes of the main Lotto Jackpot (i.e., it does not apply to the Lotto Jackpot, Lotto Million 1, or Lotto Million 2). The Illinois Lottery terminal automatically selects the Extra Shot number for the player. Matching Extra Shot increases non-top prizes.
- The player can select up to 10 plays per play slip.
- The player can play the same numbers for a maximum of 25 consecutive drawings.
- Remember: Lotto drawings are Monday, Thursday, and Saturday at 9:22 PM CT each week. The draw cutoff is 9:15 PM CT.
- For additional information on Lotto, please select the “i” button on the Photon terminal to see “Winning Numbers,” “Jackpot,” and “Game” information.



Lotto Photon terminal, Win30 terminal, and reporting updates

Photon Terminal: There are no changes to the selling steps from the Photon terminal. However, you will notice a few changes and updates on the Photon screens:

- The base price button will be displayed as \$2, an increase from \$1.
- The Lotto manual pick numbers screen will be reduced from ⑤② to ⑤① numbers (see Figure 1), and the Quick Pick option will be updated to reflect the new prices (see Figure 2).

Win30 Terminal: There will be no changes to the Win30 user interface and reporting. However, there will be changes to certain stickers:

- The price button sticker on the Quick Pick option will be updated with the new price. The new price stickers and placement instructions will be placed in the Lotto Renovation Launch kit, which will be sent directly to stores the week of March 21, 2021.
- Make sure the new price stickers are placed on the Win30 vending machines after the Lotto draw on March 29, 2021, at 9:22 PM CT.
